Program Requirements:

- All students must complete a minimum of **50 documented service hours** by the time of their graduation. Records may be kept in conjunction with the high school of concurrently enrolled students. Documentation must be signed by a member of Orlando Christian University's faculty and emailed to the Office of the Provost before graduation.
- All degree-seeking students must complete **4 additional programs or events** from the following list. Documentation of participation in the selected events must be submitted to the Office of the Provost at the time of their graduation application. A student may repeat up to two events or programs, but each event/program may only be repeated once. (E.g. a student could participate in a chapel band for two semesters, and attend summer youth camp for two summers and these combined programs would satisfy the 4 event/program requirement):
 - Participate in a semester-long discipleship group led by a faculty member
 - Participate in an international mission trip (a reflection paper must be submitted and reviewed by a faculty member)
 - Participate in a summer youth church camp as an attendee
 - Participate in a summer youth church camp as a camp counselor
 - Participate in a chapel band for 1 semester
 - Participate in a leadership position within a partner institution's student leadership offerings
 - Participate in the LifeWay or GRIP inventory and debrief seminar
 - Participate in the Royal Leadership Academy for a full 2-year cycle
- All students are required to take the following **2 classes**, designed to help students to winsomely make a case for the Christian worldview and the Christian gospel to a secular audience:
 - Apologetics
 - Capstone Course: The Bible in All of Life
